It is, therefore,

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that the *Third Motion for Summary Judgment* filed by Memorial Hospital at Gulfport is hereby GRANTED and Memorial Hospital at Gulfport shall be dismissed from this matter, with prejudice. It is further

 ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that the Motion for Summary Judgment filed by Securitron Magnalock Corporation is hereby GRANTED and Securitron Magnalock Corporation shall be dismissed from this matter, with prejudice. And it is finally

ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that all claims of the Plaintiff, Terrence D. McClendon, against Defendants, Memorial Hospital at Gulfport and Securitron Magnalock Corporation are hereby dismissed, with prejudice, with each party to bear their own costs and attorney's fees.
